



## RESOLUTION

### RELATIVE TO THE ACCEPTANCE OF DONATED MATERIALS AND TRAIL WORK WORTH APPROXIMATELY \$70,000 FROM LYNCH'S LANDSCAPING AND EXCAVATION

### *CITY OF NASHUA*

*In the Year Two Thousand and Fifteen*

**RESOLVED** by the Board of Aldermen of the City of Nashua that the City of Nashua is authorized to accept the following donated materials and trail work from Lynch's Landscaping and Excavation: 450' x 8' of natural trail, which consists of removing existing topsoil and installation of road pack gravel for the surface of the trail provided by Lynch's Landscaping and Excavation; and installation of 400' x 8' pre-manufactured boardwalk, provided by the city. The location of this work is city owned conservation land southwest of Buck Meadow Road at Cherrywood Drive (Lots C-2540 and C-2538). This project is part of the Nashua Conservation Commission's Southwest Trail project. The total value of the donation is approximately \$70,000.
