

Main Street Sidewalk Update: Aug. 21, 2015

Good Afternoon,

During the week of Aug. 17, work continued on the Main Street sidewalk project on Block 3, from East Pearl Street to Temple Street; Block 4, from Eldridge Street to East Pearl Street; and Block 5, from Eldridge Street to East Hollis Street.

A catch basin was replaced on Block 3. Old curbing and old sidewalk on Block 3 were removed and new curbing installed. Installation of electrical and irrigation conduit continued. Brickwork and plantings continued.

Next week, the final two concrete pads will be formed and poured on Block 4. A tree well will be installed. A light pole foundation will be installed on Block 3. Installation of electrical and irrigation conduit will continue. Brickwork and plantings will continue.

We appreciate your patience as we work to install new streetlights. That work is scheduled to begin by the end of the month. The Main Street Bridge lights on the east side are temporarily not working. We're working to restore the lighting.

Our schedule is tentative and subject to change due to weather or unforeseen circumstances. As always, we continue to do our best to limit obstruction of parking and impacts to businesses.
