In the Year Two Thousand and Three RESOLVED by the Board of Aldermen of the City of Nashua that the sum of \$218,000 be transferred from appropriate public works accounts into the wastewater system fund account 792-3792 "CSO Project", for the purpose of repaying the wastewater system fund for certain expenditures that were part of Sewerage Works Improvements 2002 Sewer Separation Program Contract #5 Sargents Avenue area. The expenditures that constitute the \$218,000 are as follows, which are shown on the attached memorandum: 8' black vinyl chain link fence \$25,000 Concrete pads, tables, and benches \$13,000 Bituminous paved road \$45,000 Trees, shrubs, and ground cover planting \$65,000 Precast concrete arched culvert, consisting of \$70,000 bridge and footings and masonry work _____ \$218,000 Prior to passage of this legislation, in order for the transfers to be authorized, the specific appropriate public works accounts and amounts from each account will have to be identified.
