



ORDINANCE

REMOVING THREE PARKING SPACES ON LOWELL STREET FROM THE PERMITTED OVERNIGHT ON-STREET PARKING PROGRAM

CITY OF NASHUA

In the Year Two Thousand and Sixteen

The City of Nashua ordains that Part II “General Legislation”, Chapter 320 “Vehicles and Traffic”, Article XIII “Night Parking” Section 320-78.1 “Overnight on-street parking pilot program in designated downtown areas”, subsection F of the Nashua Revised Ordinances, as amended, be and hereby is further amended by adding the following new underlined language:

“320-78.1. Overnight on-street parking pilot program in designated downtown areas.

There shall be a pilot program for on-street overnight parking as described below.

...

F. Streets where overnight parking is permitted; designated spaces.

(1) The streets where overnight parking is permitted are as follows:

Name of Street

Location

Lowell Street

Entire length except for the south side beginning at Clinton Street and extending 120 feet east”

All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby superseded only to the extent necessary to effectuate this legislation. This ordinance shall become effective when the necessary signage and pavement markings are in place.
