RESOLVED by the Board of Aldermen of the City of Nashua that the City of Nashua shall hold the State Primary Election on Tuesday, September 13, 2016 and the State General Election on Tuesday, November 8, 2016 and the polls shall be open on both days between the hours of 6:00 a.m. and 8:00 p.m.

FISCAL NOTE: Estimated cost to conduct the 2016 September 13th state primary election is \$29,327. Estimated cost to conduct the November 8th state general election is \$52,854. If the proposed increase in compensation for election officials passes, the approximate additional costs for the September 13th state primary election will be \$2,645 and for the November 8th state general election will be \$5,345. The higher costs associated with the state general election are due to the number of increased voter registrars and ballot inspectors that will be required to staff the polls for this presidential election. Additional costs are also associated with the hiring of police officers and the increase in postage costs associated with the anticipated number of absentee ballots to be mailed.

ANALYSIS

This resolution sets the polling hours for the September 13, 2016 state primary election and the November 8, 2016 general election as required under RSA 659:4.
