

Main Street Sidewalk Update: May 23, 2014

Good Afternoon,

Work progressed on the Main Street Sidewalk Project the week beginning May 19, 2014. Work continued on the West Side of Main Street between Factory Street and High Street. On this block, brick work continued. Work to cut lines into the concrete was finished.

Work began from High Street to West Pearl Street. Trees and stumps were removed, and streetlights and bollards were removed. Old curbing was removed and new granite curbing installed. Electrical and irrigation conduit was installed to TD Bank. Three catch basins were replaced. Paving inside and outside the curb was completed. Two tree wells were installed in front of Scontsas Jewelers.

In the coming week, beginning Tuesday, brick work will continue from Factory Street to High Street. Also, work will continue from High Street to West Pearl Street. A granite planter in front of Scontsas Jewelers will be installed. Conduit work will be completed in the area for the fountain. Existing sidewalks will be removed. Three concrete pads and a tip-down will be formed and poured in front of Scontsas Jewelers.

Our schedule is tentative and subject to change due to weather or unforeseen circumstances. As always, we continue to do our best to limit obstruction of parking and impacts to businesses.
