



ORDINANCE

ESTABLISHING TWO FIFTEEN MINUTE PARKING TIME LIMIT ZONES ON PORTIONS OF ARLINGTON STREET AND GILLIS STREET

CITY OF NASHUA

In the Year Two Thousand and Sixteen

The City of Nashua ordains that Part II “General Legislation”, Chapter 320 “Vehicles and Traffic”, Article X “Parking Time Limits in Non-Parking-Lot Areas”, Section 320-35 “Fifteen-minute parking”, subsection A of the Nashua Revised Ordinances, as amended, be hereby further amended by adding the new underlined language in alphabetical order as follows:

“§ 320-35. Fifteen-minute parking.

- A. No vehicle shall be stationed or remain for a period exceeding 15 minutes on the following streets:

Name of Street	Side	Location

<u>Arlington Street</u>	<u>West</u>	<u>Beginning at a point 30 feet south of Gillis Street and extending southerly to a point 50 feet south of Gillis Street</u>
<u>Gillis Street</u>	<u>South</u>	<u>Beginning at a point 25 feet west of Arlington Street and extending westerly to a point 65 feet west of Arlington Street”</u>

All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

This ordinance shall become effective at the time of removal and/or installation of the necessary sign(s) and/or pavement markings.

ANALYSIS

This legislation establishes two new 15 minute parking time limit zones on small portions of Arlington Street and Gillis Street, near the intersection of those two streets. This would cover one space on Arlington Street and two spaces on Gillis Street. These zones keep parking at least 25 feet from intersecting streets and 2 feet from driveways.
