



ORDINANCE

EXTENDING THE OVERNIGHT ON-STREET PARKING PROGRAM INDEFINITELY AND ALLOWING RESIDENTS OF ATWOOD COURT, ORANGE STREET AND WHITNEY STREET TO PURCHASE OVERNIGHT ON-STREET PARKING PERMITS

CITY OF NASHUA

In the Year Two Thousand and Sixteen

The City of Nashua ordains that Part II “General Legislation”, Chapter 320 “Vehicles and Traffic”, Article XIII “Night Parking”, Section 320-78.1 “Overnight on-street parking pilot program in designated downtown area” of the Nashua Revised Ordinances, as amended, be and hereby is further amended by deleting the struck-through language and adding the new underlined language as follows:

“320-78.1. Overnight on-street parking pilot program in designated downtown area.

There shall be a pilot program for on-street overnight parking as described below.

~~A. This pilot program shall expire December 31, 2016, unless reauthorized. The judgment regarding the success of the pilot program shall include, but not be limited to, the following factors:~~

- ~~1. the number of residents who obtain permits;~~
- ~~2. a favorable recommendation from the Police Department;~~
- ~~3. a favorable recommendation from the Fire Department; and~~
- ~~4. a favorable recommendation from the Public Works Division.~~

BA. On-street overnight parking shall be allowed between the hours of 12:00 a.m. and 6:00 a.m. on designated streets only to vehicles with a permit. On-street overnight parking for any time period between the hours of 12:00 a.m. and 6:00 a.m. on designated streets without a permit is a violation of § 320-78 and is not allowed.

1. Residents of the streets where overnight parking is permitted will be allowed to purchase an annual permit, with a maximum number of 400 permits to be issued. Additionally, residents of the following locations are also allowed to purchase annual permits:

- a. 13 Main Street
- b. Buck Street
- c. 136 West Pearl Street
- d. Railroad Square
- e. Mulberry Street
- f. Salem Street
- g. Orange Street
- h. Whitney Street
- i. Atwood Court
