



ORDINANCE

PROHIBITING PARKING ON A PORTION OF MANCHESTER STREET NEAR THE TOWN OF MERRIMACK BORDER

CITY OF NASHUA

In the Year Two Thousand and Seventeen

The City of Nashua ordains that Part II “General Legislation”, Chapter 320 “Vehicles and Traffic”, Article XII “Parking, Stopping and Standing”, Section 320-69 “No parking on certain streets” of the Nashua Revised Ordinances, as amended, be hereby further amended by adding the new underlined language in alphabetical order as follows:

“§ 320-69. **No parking on certain streets.**

No parking whatsoever shall be permitted on the following streets, except as provided by law:

All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

This ordinance shall become effective at the time of removal and/or installation of the necessary sign(s) and/or pavement markings.
