

Main Street Sidewalk Update: April 18, 2014

Good Afternoon,

With weather cooperating for the most part, we have been working diligently on the Main Street Sidewalk Project the week beginning April 14, 2014.

Work continued on the West Side of Main Street between Factory Street to the North and High Street to the South. Tree stumps were excavated, and the free-standing clock and kiosk were carefully removed and placed in storage. A light pole at the corner of High and Main streets also was removed, and an underground vault in front of Yogurt in Love was repaired. Old curbing along the block was demolished, and new curbing installed.

We anticipate continuing work along this section of Main Street beginning Monday, April 21, 2014. Sidewalk in front of Yogurt in Love will be demolished. A granite planter and an underground conduit for electrical wires and irrigation pipes will be put in place. Four tree wells and the foundations for two streetlight poles will be installed. Also, workers will form and pour tip-downs at the corner to allow sidewalk access for disabled pedestrians.

Our schedule is tentative and subject to change due to weather or unforeseen circumstances. As always, we continue to do our best to limit obstruction of parking and impacts to businesses.
