

Main Street Sidewalk Update: Aug. 8, 2014

Good Afternoon,

During the week of Aug. 4, work progressed on the Main Street sidewalk project on Block 3 between High and West Pearl Streets and Block 4 from East Pearl Street to Santander Bank on the West side.

Old sidewalk was removed on Block 4, and electrical and irrigation conduit extended to Joanne's Restaurant & Coffee Shop. A tree well and streetlight foundation were installed. Liberty Utilities replaced two gas lines. One concrete pad was formed and poured, and the granite planter in front of Aubuchon Hardware was installed. Night work continued on Block 2 at the mid-block crosswalk at 100 Main Street with the installation of granite curbing across Main Street. Brick work and plantings continued.

Next week, Liberty Utilities will replace a gas line on Block 4. Concrete pads will be formed and poured, and the installation of electrical and irrigation conduit will continue to the end of Block 4. Two tree wells, a light pole foundation and a granite planter in front of Santander Bank will be installed. Brick work will continue.

Our schedule is tentative and subject to change due to weather or unforeseen circumstances. As always, we continue to do our best to limit obstruction of parking and impacts to businesses.
