

June 21, 2013 Sidewalk Update

Good Afternoon,

During the week of June 17, we formed and poured four concrete pads, installed conduit, continued the brick work and installed a granite planter. We also installed the finish grade pavement on the southbound side of the mid-block crosswalk on the Main Street Bridge.

Next Week we plan to form and pour the two tip downs for the crosswalk and the last concrete pad on the west side of Block 2. We will install a light pole foundation. Extensive electrical work will be completed. The brick work will continue on the west side of Block 2. Plants will begin to be planted in the planters and the green space as designed by our landscape architects. In addition, the finish grade pavement will be installed on the northbound side of the mid-block crosswalk on the Main Street Bridge. The Main Street Bridge crosswalk work will be done overnight to minimize impacts to traffic. A sandwich board will be placed on the bridge on the day we plan to do the overnight work as additional notification. Green carpet will continue to be used to clearly indicate that you are open for business.

We will do our best to limit the obstruction of parking and impacts to your business. Unfortunately, it is necessary to take parking spaces where we are working. Our schedule is tentative and subject to change due to unforeseen circumstances or inclement weather. We have made great progress over the past couple of weeks.
