



ORDINANCE

REMOVING THE PARKING METERS AND ESTABLISHING A TWO-HOUR PARKING TIME LIMIT ON COTTAGE STREET

CITY OF NASHUA

In the Year Two Thousand and Seventeen

The City of Nashua ordains that Part II “General Legislation”, Chapter 320 “Vehicles and Traffic”, of the Nashua Revised Ordinances, as amended, be hereby further amended by deleting the struck-through language and adding the new underlined language in the appropriate alphabetical order as follows:

1. In Article X “Parking Time Limits in Non-Parking-Lot Areas”, Section 320-38 “Two-hour parking”, subsection A:

“§ 320-38. Two-hour parking.

A. Parking shall be limited to two hours at all times on the following streets:

<u>Cottage Street</u>	<u>East</u>	<u>From Temple Street to the library parking lot</u>
<u>Cottage Street</u>	<u>Both</u>	<u>Between Temple Street and East Pearl Street”</u>

2. In Article XI “Parking Meters”, Section 320-51 “Parking meter streets”, subsection C:

“§ 320-51. Parking meter streets.

...

C. Zone III.

Name of Street	Side	Location
...		
Cottage Street	East	From Temple Street to the library parking lot
Cottage Street	Both	between Temple Street and East Pearl Street”

All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

This ordinance shall become effective at the time of removal of the parking meters and installation of the necessary sign(s).
