



ORDINANCE

ESTABLISHING A TWO-HOUR PARKING TIME LIMIT ON QUINCY STREET

CITY OF NASHUA

In the Year Two Thousand and Seventeen

The City of Nashua ordains that Part II “General Legislation”, Chapter 320 “Vehicles and Traffic”, Article X “Parking Time Limits in Non-Parking-Lot Areas”, Section 320-38 “Two-hour parking”, subsection A of the Nashua Revised Ordinances, as amended, be hereby further amended by adding the new underlined language in the appropriate alphabetical order as follows:

“§ 320-38. Two-hour parking.

A. Parking shall be limited to two hours at all times on the following streets:

Name of Street	Side	Location

<u>Quincy Street</u>	<u>West</u>	<u>Entire length</u> ”

All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

This ordinance shall become effective at the time of removal and/or installation of the necessary sign(s).
