



ORDINANCE

ADDING ADDITIONAL STREETS TO THE OVERNIGHT ON-STREET PARKING PROGRAM TEMPORARILY

CITY OF NASHUA

In the Year Two Thousand and Seventeen

The City of Nashua ordains that Part II “General Legislation”, Chapter 320 “Vehicles and Traffic”, Article XIII “Night Parking” Section 320-78.1 “Overnight on-street parking program in designated downtown areas” of the Nashua Revised Ordinances, as amended, be and hereby is further amended by deleting the struck-through language, appropriately renumbering / relettering subsequent items, and adding the new underlined language in the appropriate alphabetical order:

“320-78.1. Overnight on-street parking program in designated downtown areas.

There shall be a program for on-street overnight parking as described below.

A. ...

- (1) Residents of the streets where overnight parking is permitted will be allowed to purchase an annual permit, with a maximum number of 550 permits to be issued. Additionally, residents of the following locations are also allowed to purchase annual permits:

¹Permitted overnight parking on these streets or portions of streets is only authorized through December 31, 2018.”

All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby superseded only to the extent necessary to effectuate this legislation.

This ordinance shall become effective when the necessary signage and pavement markings are in place.
