



## ORDINANCE

### REGARDING ACCEPTANCE OF PROCEDURAL MOTIONS WITHOUT OBJECTION

### *CITY OF NASHUA*

*In the Year Two Thousand and Eighteen*

*The City of Nashua ordains* that Part I “Administrative Legislation”, Chapter 5 “Administration of Government”, Part 2 “Board of Aldermen”, Article III “Rules and Order of Business”, Section 5-24 “Other applicable rules” of the Nashua Revised Ordinances, as amended, be hereby further amended by adding the new underlined subsection as follows:

“§ 5-24. Other applicable rules.

...

E. The presiding officer of the Board, or a committee, may request of the Board or committee that any procedural motion be accepted in the absence of objections by members of the Board or committee.”
