



## ORDINANCE

### PROHIBITING PARKING ON BOTH SIDES OF THE ENTIRE LENGTH OF FRONT STREET

#### CITY OF NASHUA

*In the Year Two Thousand and Eighteen*

*The City of Nashua ordains* that Part II “General Legislation”, Chapter 320 “Vehicles and Traffic”, Article XII “Parking, Stopping and Standing”, Section 320-69 “No parking on certain streets” of the Nashua Revised Ordinances, as amended, be hereby further amended by deleting the struck-through language and adding the new underlined language in alphabetical order as follows:

**“§ 320-69. No parking on certain streets.**

No parking whatsoever shall be permitted on the following streets, except as provided by law:

<del>Front Street</del>	<del>Both</del>	<del>From the west intersection of Franklin Street south to a point where Front Street turns and runs southeast</del>

<del>Front Street</del>	<del>South and East</del>	<del>At Franklin Street</del>
<del>Front Street</del>	<del>West</del>	<del>At Charles Street and Franklin Street</del>
<u>Front Street</u>	<u>Both</u>	<u>Entire length</u>

All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

This ordinance shall become effective at the time of removal and/or installation of the necessary sign(s) and/or pavement markings.
