ANALYSIS

This resolution authorizes the transfer of up to \$50,000 from Contingency, Negotiations to various salary & wages accounts as appropriate to fund the FY2018 salary adjustments in accordance with the new Unaffiliated Employees' plan. Legislation to revise the existing "Merit Employee Rules and Regulations", dated July 1, 2011, to be called the "City of Nashua Unaffiliated Employees Personnel Policies", dated January 1, 2018, is being submitted simultaneously.

Charter Sec. 53 permits the Board of Aldermen to transfer any unencumbered appropriation balance or any portion from one department, fund or agency to another. NRO 5-130, H provides that "when proposed legislation to transfer or re-appropriate a particular appropriation or purpose thereof has had its first reading, such funds shall not be expended or transferred while the legislation is pending".
