



ORDINANCE

ADDING ADDITIONAL FIRE STATION SIGNAL LOCATIONS

CITY OF NASHUA

In the Year Two Thousand and Eighteen

The City of Nashua ordains that Part II “General Legislation”, Chapter 320 “Vehicles and Traffic”, Article III “Stop and Yield Intersections”, Section 320-6 “Fire station signals” of the Nashua Revised Ordinances, as amended, be hereby further amended by adding the new underlined language in alphabetical order as follows:

“§ 320-6. Fire station signals.

The following locations shall have traffic signals installed and maintained in accordance with the standards established by the United States Department of Transportation's Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices of 1971, or as may be amended or revised, and the State Department of Public Works and Highways' Traffic Division Standards on Fire Station Signals. Such signals shall be designed so as to indicate a flashing amber indication in each approaching direction during normal operation and a steady red indication at such times as deemed appropriate by the City Fire Department.
