



ORDINANCE

ESTABLISHING A NO PARKING ZONE ON THE WEST SIDE OF PINE STREET

CITY OF NASHUA

In the Year Two Thousand and Eighteen

The City of Nashua ordains that Part II “General Legislation”, Chapter 320 “Vehicles and Traffic”, Article XII “Parking, Stopping and Standing”, Section 320-70 “No parking certain hours and days” of the Nashua Revised Ordinances, as amended, hereby be further amended by adding the new underlined language as follows:

“§ 320-70. No parking certain hours and days.
