



## ORDINANCE

### ALLOWING PERMITTED OVERNIGHT ON-STREET PARKING INDEFINITELY ON THOSE STREETS WHERE IT IS TEMPORARILY PERMITTED

#### *CITY OF NASHUA*

*In the Year Two Thousand and Eighteen*

*The City of Nashua ordains* that Part II “General Legislation”, Chapter 320 “Vehicles and Traffic”, Article XIII “Night Parking” Section 320-78.1 “Overnight on-street parking program in designated downtown areas”, subsection E of the Nashua Revised Ordinances, as amended, be and hereby is further amended by deleting the struck-through language as shown:

**“320-78.1. Overnight on-street parking program in designated downtown areas.**

E. The streets where overnight parking is permitted are as follows:

All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby superseded only to the extent necessary to effectuate this legislation.

This ordinance shall become effective when the necessary signage and pavement markings are in place.

**ANALYSIS**

O-17-051, Amended ("Adding additional streets to the overnight on-street parking program temporarily") added portions of seven streets on a temporary trial basis (through December 31, 2018) to the list of streets where permitted overnight on-street parking is allowed. This legislation allows permitted overnight on-street parking on those same portions of streets indefinitely (removes the expiration date).
