



ORDINANCE

MOVING THE LOCATION OF A YIELD SIGN AT THE INTERSECTION OF WALNUT STREET AND CENTRAL STREET

CITY OF NASHUA

In the Year Two Thousand and Eighteen

The City of Nashua ordains that Part II “General Legislation”, Chapter 320 “Vehicles and Traffic”, Article III “Stop and Yield Intersections”, Section 320-5 “Yield intersections”, subsection C, of the Nashua Revised Ordinances, as amended, be hereby further amended by deleting the struck-through language and adding the following new underlined language in the appropriate alphabetical order:

“§ 320-5. Yield intersections.

...

C. The following shall be yield intersections:

Yield Sign on

At Intersection With

...

~~Central Street~~ Walnut Street

~~Walnut Street~~ Central Street”

All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

This ordinance shall become effective at the time of removal and/or installation of the necessary sign(s) and/or device(s).

ANALYSIS

This legislation authorizes moving the existing yield sign on Central Street at its intersection with Walnut Street to instead having the yield sign on Walnut Street at the same intersection (with Central Street).

The erection, removal and maintenance of all traffic control devices must conform to applicable state statutes and the latest edition of the manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices. RSA 47:17 VIII (a). The Board should consult with the city's Traffic Engineer to determine if this ordinance is in compliance.
