



## ORDINANCE

### DESIGNATING PARKING ON CHESTNUT STREET FOR FIRE DEPARTMENT EMPLOYEES

### *CITY OF NASHUA*

*In the Year Two Thousand and Eighteen*

*The City of Nashua ordains* that Part II “General Legislation”, Chapter 320 “Vehicles and Traffic”, Article XII “Parking, Stopping and Standing”, Section 320-55 “Parking by authorized vehicles only in designated areas” of the Nashua Revised Ordinances, as amended, hereby be further amended by adding the new underlined language as follows:

“§ 320-55. Parking by authorized vehicles only in designated areas.

...

C. Parking shall be designated for Fire Department employees only on the west side of Chestnut Street, beginning at a point 80 feet south of Lake Street and running northerly a distance of 40 feet. These restrictions are in effect weekdays only, 7:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m.”

All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

This ordinance shall become effective at the time of removal and/or installation of the necessary sign(s).
