



ORDINANCE

DESIGNATING THE SOUTHWEST CONSERVATION AREA AS CITY CONSERVATION LAND

CITY OF NASHUA

In the Year Two Thousand and Nineteen

The City of Nashua ordains that Part II “General Legislation”, Chapter 215 “Parks and Recreation Areas”, Article III “Conservation Lands”, Section 215-9 “Conservation lands designated” of the Nashua Revised Ordinances, as amended, be hereby further amended by adding the new underlined language as follows:

“§ 215-9. Conservation lands designated.

- A. The following lands are hereby designated conservation lands of the City of Nashua:
 - (1) The Northwest Sanctuary.
 - (2) The Southwest Conservation Area.
- B. Any appropriate mappings or descriptions of such lands are incorporated by reference.
- C. Additional conservation areas shall be designated by amendment to this section.”

A map identifying the Southwest Conservation Area is attached.

This ordinance shall become effective immediately upon passage.
