



## RESOLUTION

### EXTENDING AND ENLARGING THE NASHUA RAIL TRANSIT COMMITTEE

### *CITY OF NASHUA*

*In the Year Two Thousand and Nineteen*

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to R-17-123 and R-17-161, the City has a Nashua Rail Transit Committee (“Committee”) that has been established as follows:

The committee consists of nine (9) members as follows: two (2) members of the Board of Aldermen, who shall be appointed by the President of the Board of Aldermen; one (1) member from the Nashua Regional Planning Commission, who shall be appointed by the Executive Director of the Commission; one (1) member from the Greater Nashua Chamber of Commerce, who shall be appointed by the Chamber’s President/CEO; two (2) residents of the City of Nashua, who shall be appointed by the Mayor; one (1) member who shall be the Mayor or his or her designee; and two (2) members who are the City’s representatives on the New Hampshire Rail Transit Authority.

The Committee is charged with making recommendations and development of a strategy to the Mayor and the Board of Aldermen for bringing passenger rail to Nashua. This includes, but is not limited to working with Boston Surface Rail Company as articulated in the Memorandum of Understanding executed by the City.

The appointed members shall serve at the pleasure of the appointing authority and promulgate said recommendations and a communication no later than June 30, 2018.

**WHEREAS**, the City would like to extend and enlarge the Committee.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Board of Aldermen of the City of Nashua that the Committee will continue indefinitely, and the Committee will have the following additional members: the State of New Hampshire Executive Councilor representing Nashua; the two (2) State of New Hampshire State Senators representing Nashua; the State of New Hampshire State Representatives representing Nashua who are on the Public Works and Highways Standing Committee; and two (2) additional residents of the City of Nashua, who shall be appointed by the Mayor.
