



ORDINANCE

REMOVING THE THIRTY-MINUTE PARKING TIME LIMIT ON A PORTION OF THE WEST SIDE OF WALNUT STREET

CITY OF NASHUA

In the Year Two Thousand and Nineteen

The City of Nashua ordains that Part II “General Legislation”, Chapter 320 “Vehicles and Traffic”, Article X “Parking Time Limits in Non-Parking-Lot Areas”, Section 320-36 “Thirty-minute parking”, of the Nashua Revised Ordinances, as amended, be hereby further amended by deleting the struck-through language as follows:

“§ 320-36. Thirty-minute parking.

No vehicle shall be stationed or remain for a period exceeding 30 minutes on the following streets:

Name of Street	Side	Hours	Location

Walnut Street	West	All	From the Cedar Street extension to West Pearl Street”

All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

This ordinance shall become effective at the time of removal and/or installation of the necessary sign(s) and/or device(s).
