



ORDINANCE

INCREASING THE PARKING TIME LIMIT AT METERS IN ZONE I

CITY OF NASHUA

In the Year Two Thousand and Nineteen

The City of Nashua ordains that Part II “General Legislation”, Chapter 320 “Vehicles and Traffic”, Article XI “Parking Meters”, Section 320-50 “Parking time limits on streets”, subsection C(1), of the Nashua Revised Ordinances, as amended, be hereby further amended by deleting the struck-through language and adding the new underlined language as follows:

“§ 320-50. **Parking time limits on streets.**

...

C. The parking time limit on all parking meter streets shall be as follows:

(1) In Zone I: ~~ninety-minute~~ one-hundred-twenty-minute time limit.”

All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

This ordinance shall become effective at the time of removal and/or installation of the necessary sign(s) and/or device(s).
