



ORDINANCE

PROHIBITING PARKING ON ALAN STREET BETWEEN 7 A.M. AND 10 A.M.
MONDAY THROUGH FRIDAY WHILE SCHOOL IS IN SESSION

CITY OF NASHUA

In the Year Two Thousand and Nineteen

The City of Nashua ordains that Part II “General Legislation”, Chapter 320 “Vehicles and Traffic”, Article XII “Parking, Stopping and Standing”, Section 320-70 “No parking certain hours and days” of the Nashua Revised Ordinances, as amended, be hereby further amended by adding the new underlined language in alphabetical order as follows:

“§ 320-70. No parking certain hours and days.

No parking whatsoever shall be permitted on the following streets during the hours and days indicated:

All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

This ordinance shall become effective at the time of removal and/or installation of the necessary sign(s).


