RESOLVED by the Board of Aldermen of the City of Nashua that the City of Nashua is authorized to accept and appropriate \$356,046 of Federal grant funds from the U.S. Department of Transportation, Federal Transit Administration, and \$26,828 from the State of New Hampshire Department of Transportation into Transit Grant Activity "Transit Low or No Emission Grant Program" for the purpose of purchasing 2 electric vans, 1 electric vehicle and related electrical upgrades and charging stations. Matching funds in the amount of \$34,828 are required for this grant of which \$26,828 is currently allocated for van replacements in the City's CERF plan, and the remainder of \$8,000 will be funded through matching funds from the City's General Fund.
