**RESOLVED** by the Board of Aldermen of the City of Nashua that the City of Nashua is authorized to accept and appropriate additional funds in the amount of \$7,060.53 from the State of New Hampshire, Department of Transportation into Grant Activity “Safe Routes to School – Charlotte Avenue” for the purpose of improving pedestrian infrastructure near the Charlotte Avenue Elementary School. These funds are in addition to \$100,000 of funds previously authorized under R-14-005. Matching funds in the amount of \$231,752.14 are required for this grant and will be funded as follows:

**ANALYSIS**

This resolution authorizes the city to accept and appropriate funds from the State of New Hampshire, Department of Transportation into Grant Activity “Safe Routes to School – Charlotte Avenue” for the purpose of improving pedestrian infrastructure near the Charlotte Avenue Elementary School. These funds are in addition to \$100,000 of funds previously authorized under R-14-005. Matching funds in the amount of \$231,752.14 are required for this grant.

The grant agreement requires the City to provide for subsequent maintenance of all project elements, together with maintenance of sidewalks, which includes winter snow and ice removal.

This project was submitted to the Capital Improvements Committee for FY21.
