**AUTHORIZING A REDUCTION OF A \$330.00 VARIANCE APPLICATION FEE TO
WIDEN DRIVEWAY AT 16 HIDEAWAY ROAD TO \$50.00**

In the Year Two Thousand and Twenty

WHEREAS, property owner Debra Milne applied for and was granted a variance to expand her existing garage at 16 Hideaway Road in March 2020. She then sought a permit to widen her second driveway which would require an additional variance. Had she been aware of the need for a driveway variance originally, she would have added the request to her application for the garage and paid \$50.00 for a second variance request. To apply for the driveway variance separately, she would need to submit a \$330.00 application fee.

RESOLVED by the Board of Aldermen of the City of Nashua that the City is authorized to reduce the \$330.00 variance application fee to widen the second driveway at 16 Hideaway Road to \$50.00
