**RESOLVED** by the Board of Aldermen of the City of Nashua authorizes the interfund transfer and appropriation of \$325,000 from the Broad Street Parkway Capital Project Activity to the Nashua Millyard Dog Park Capital Project Activity for the purchase of Property located a “L” Pine Street (Map 77, Lot 5)).

**FISCAL NOTE:** This resolution transfers and appropriates \$325,000 from one capital project activity to another capital project activity.

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**ANALYSIS**

This resolution authorizes the Interfund Transfer and appropriation of \$325,000 from the Broad Street Parkway Capital Project Activity to the Nashua Millyard Dog Park Capital Project Activity for the purchase of Property located a “L” Pine Street (Map 77, Lot 5).

Charter Sec. 53 permits the Board of Aldermen to transfer any unencumbered appropriation balance or any portion thereof from one department, fund or agency to another. NRO § 5-130, H provides that “when proposed legislation to transfer or reappropriate a particular appropriation or portion thereof has had its first reading, such funds shall not be expended or transferred while the legislation is pending”.

Charter Sec. 53 permits specific non-budget, supplementary appropriations. There should be notice and a public hearing. A two-thirds vote is required under Charter Sec. 56-b for an item or amount not in the mayor’s budget. A roll call is required under Charter Sec. 49.

Charter §77-a states that all requests for capital improvement projects...shall be referred to the [capital improvement] committee for a recommendation prior to any formal commitment by the city to proceed.
