



ORDINANCE

PROVIDING FOR ALDERMEN-AT-LARGE TO ACT IN COMMITTEES TO MEET REQUIREMENT THAT QUORUMS BE PHYSICALLY PRESENT

CITY OF NASHUA

In the Year Two Thousand and Twenty-One

The City of Nashua ordains that Part I “Administrative Legislation”, Chapter 5 “Administration of Government”, Part 2 “Board of Aldermen”, Article II “General Provisions”, Section 5-9 “Standing committees.” of the Nashua Revised Ordinances, as amended, be hereby further amended by deleting the struck-through language and adding the new underlined language as follows:

“§ 5-9. Standing committees.

...

- C. When a standing committee lacks a quorum of members as provided in ~~Subsections A and B~~ physically present, any Alderman at Large who is physically present where said meeting is held, selected by the Chairman of the committee, shall be deemed to be a member of said committee pro tem for the purposes of establishing a quorum ~~thereof~~ being physically present and voting. An appointed member who is not physically present may in accordance with RSA 91-A:2, III participate in the meeting, but shall not have a vote if an Alderman at Large is serving in his or her stead, pro tem. Should an appointed member arrive at the meeting thereafter, pro tem members shall step down, and shall have no vote unless to do so would render the committee without a quorum.
