**Bill Text:** **DELETING THE OBSOLETE REFERENCES IN THE SCHOOL STREET PARAGRAPH OF THE ONE-WAY STREETS ORDINANCE**

In the Year Two Thousand and Three The City of Nashua ordains that Chapter 13 "Motor Vehicles and Traffic", Article IV "Operation of Motor Vehicles", Division 5 "One-way Streets", Section 13-141 "At all times", the paragraph entitled "School Street", as amended, be further amended by deleting the struck through language and adding the new underlined language as follows: "School Street: All vehicles operating on School Street shall enter from High Street at an entrance approximately twenty (20) feet west of the west line of Harrison Street and travel in a southerly direction for approximately one hundred sixty-five (165) feet, thence after a ninety-degree turn in an easterly direction for approximately three hundred (300) feet, thence, after a ninety-degree turn in a northerly direction for approximately one hundred sixty-five (165) feet and entering High Street at approximately fifteen (15) feet east of the east line of Washington Street; aAll vehicles operating on School Street between Walnut Street and High Street shall travel in an easterly and northerly direction."
