



## ORDINANCE

### AMENDING VIOLATIONS AND PENALTIES FOR STOPPING, STANDING OR PARKING VIOLATIONS

### *CITY OF NASHUA*

*In the Year Two Thousand and Four*

*The City of Nashua ordains* that Chapter 13 “Motor Vehicles and Traffic”, Article V “Parking and Stopping”, Division 7 “Violations and Penalties”, Section 13-351 “Stopping, Standing or Parking Violations”, of the Nashua Revised Ordinances, is hereby amended by adding the following paragraph at the end of subsection (b):

“It will constitute a separate offense from the original violation of a legal parking time limit contained in sections 13-215 through 13-222, 13-249 through 13-251, 13-293 and 13-311, for each subsequent like period of time thereafter during which a person permits or causes a vehicle to remain parked in the location where the original violation occurred.”

All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

This ordinance shall become effective at the time of passage.

**ANALYSIS**

This ordinance would specify that a person who has committed an initial overtime parking violation will be deemed to have committed additional violations for each subsequent period of equal time thereafter during which that person allows the vehicle to remain parked in that location. For example, a person who violates a thirty-minute parking time limit would be subject to additional tickets for each additional thirty minutes during which the vehicle remained illegally parked.
