Bill Text: **CHANGING THE CLOSING TIME OF THE SUNSET HEIGHTS PARK FROM 10:00 P.M. TO DUSK**

In the Year Two Thousand and Three The City of Nashua ordains that Chapter 15 "Parks, Recreation and Sports", Article II "Parks and Playgrounds", Section 15-16 "Prohibited acts", subsection (b) as amended, hereby be further amended by adding the new underlined language and deleting the struckthrough language as follows: "Sec. 15-16. Prohibited acts. ... (b) No person may remain, stay or loiter in or on the Deschenes Oval, Sandy Pond Park, Bicentennial Park or Monument Park between the hours of 9:00 p.m. and 6:00 a.m., and no person may remain, stay or loiter in any other city park except for Sunset Heights Park between the hours of 10:00 p.m. and 6:00 a.m., except under the direction of or by permission of the park superintendent. No person may remain, stay or loiter in the Sunset Heights Park between the hours of dusk and 6 a.m., except under the direction of or by permission of the park superintendent." All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.
