**Bill Text:** **REPEALING THE TWO-HOUR PARKING RESTRICTION ON THE NORTH SIDE OF PROSPECT STREET BETWEEN DEARBORN STREET AND HARBOR AVENUE**

In the Year Two Thousand and Three The City of Nashua ordains that Chapter 13 "Motor Vehicles and Traffic", Article V "Parking and Stopping", Division 2 "Parking Time Limits in Non-parking-lot Areas", Section 13-220 "Two-hour parking" subsection (a) of the Nashua Revised Ordinances, as amended, is hereby amended by deleting the struck-through language and adding the new underlined language as follows: "Prospect Street, north side, from Dearborn Street to Harbor Avenue South side, from Main Street easterly for a distance of three hundred fifty-five (355) feet."
