Bill Text: **PROHIBITING PARKING ON THE SOUTH SIDE OF CAMPTON STREET EXCEPT FOR THOSE USING IT FOR RIVER ACCESS OR RECREATIONAL USE**

In the Year Two Thousand and Three The City of Nashua ordains that Chapter 13 "Motor Vehicles and Traffic", Article V "Parking and Stopping, Division 4 "No Parking, Standing or Stopping in Specified Areas", of the Nashua Revised Ordinances, as amended, be further amended by adding the following new section: "Sec. 13-294. Parking regulations on private roads adjacent to city-owned land. The following parking regulations relative to private roads adjacent to city-owned land shall be in effect: Campton Street: No motor vehicle parking on the south side of Campton Street except for those using it for river access or recreational use." All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed. This ordinance shall become effective at the time of installation of the necessary signs.
