



ORDINANCE

ESTABLISHING A 25 M.P.H. SPEED LIMIT ON LONG AVENUE

CITY OF NASHUA

In the Year Two Thousand and Four

The City of Nashua ordains that Chapter 13 “Motor Vehicles and Traffic”, Article IV “Operation of Motor Vehicles”, Division 4 “Speed Limits”, Section 13-121 “Speed limit signs”, subsection (a)(6) thereof of the revised ordinances of Nashua, as amended, be and is hereby further amended by adding the following street to the twenty-five (25) miles per hour list in the appropriate alphabetical order:

“Long Avenue”

All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

This ordinance shall become effective at the time of removal and installation of the appropriate signs.

ANALYSIS

This ordinance establishes a 25 m.p.h. speed limit on Long Avenue.

NH RSA 265:63 allows the board of aldermen to pass this legislation if the board determines, on the basis of an engineering or traffic investigation, that the prima facie speed normally permitted by NH RSA 256:60 and NRO 13-121 is greater or less than is reasonable and safe under the conditions found to exist upon these streets. The speed limit for these streets may not be decreased to less than 25 mph. NH RSA 265:63.
