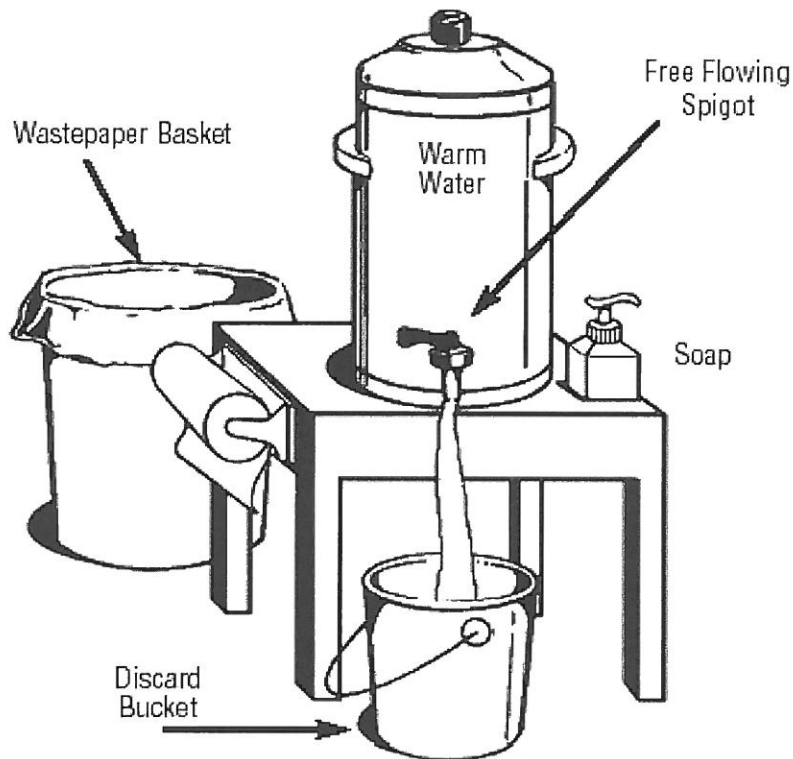

## Temporary Hand-wash Set-up

- Hand-washing facilities shall not be used for cleaning utensils, equipment, or other surfaces.
- All food/beverage products, equipment, utensils, and single service items must be protected from any splash or spillage from hand wash activities.
- An adequate supply of pump soap and disposable paper towels shall be provided at each hand-wash station. Paper towels shall be properly disposed of in covered waste receptacle after use.
- Minimum 2-5 gallons of potable hot water will be maintained in a container capable of dispensing water through a continuous flow valve to keep hands free while washing hands.
- Waste water will be collected and disposed of to a sanitary sewer, **not** onto the ground or into storm drains.
- Waste water collection bucket must have a capacity at least 15 percent greater than the potable water container.
