Dear Dr. Tempelman:

I am in receipt of your letter dated November 29, 2007.

As it appears that this letter also serves as your final campaign receipts and expenditures report, a copy of that letter and this acknowledgement will be put on file with the candidates' December 6th campaign finance disclosures.

Although you did, as you state in this letter, request an "immediate hand recount" of the ballots cast for Alderman in Ward 4, the city charter is very specific as to the timeframe in which that recount can occur: from seven days following the date of the election (November 13) to seven days thereafter (November 20).

You were well aware that the most likely date for the recount would be November 17th, as you referenced that date in your letter requesting the recount. Yet there was nothing in your letter which indicated you had a conflict with that date, that you would prefer a specific alternative date, nor did you provide contact information for yourself or a representative even though you knew, as you stated in your letter of November 29th, that you "had long-standing plans to be away from Nashua and out of the country for a couple of weeks."

The Board of Aldermen called a special meeting for November 17, which met the requirements of the city charter and did not result in the cancellation or re-scheduling of other Aldermanic committee meetings already posted.

Following are my responses to your questions:

1. Marc Plamondon 502, Andrew Tempelman 209. (These were the "exact total number of votes cast on the voting ballot machine." Official returns were: Marc Plamondon 502, Andrew Tempelman 210. There was one handcounted ballot.)
2. Unknown. I am not knowledgeable about Channel 13's election night news-gathering or news-reporting processes.
3. Unknown. I was not present at that location at that time.

4. The tabulator tape was signed by David Davis, Shirley Santerre, Henry Labine Jr., illegible signature (may be Clarence Krammes), and James Barnett. As I was not present at the closing of the Ward 4 polling place, I have no idea how many others witnessed the machine results. The tallying process is conducted in public, and any number of candidates and/or interested parties could have been in attendance. (Copy of election officials' contact information is attached.)
5. List attached.
6. Unknown. See answer to #2.
7. Ballots "issued": 1,400 blanks + 49 absentee ballots + 1 AVS ballot = 1,450
8. Closing ballot tally: 664 uncast ballots + 776 cast ballots + 1 AVS ballot + 9 voided ballots = 1,450
9. *Return of Votes* are delivered by election officials to the City Clerk's Office on election night. It is unknown how many people reviewed the returns at the polling place on election night, or have done so at the City Clerk's Office since.
10. Not applicable.
11. No.
12. Bar-coding and ballot numbering systems are not authorized under state law.
13. Unknown. See answer to #2.
14. No numbers are called into the City Clerk's Office. Results are hand delivered, in writing, by a ward election official.
15. The applicable statute relative to recount fees for municipal elections is RSA 669:31. Request for advance payment of the recount fee was made following consultation with Corporation Counsel. The statute uses the phrase "shall pay" and, as you correctly note, there are provisions for repayment of all or a portion of that fee depending upon the margin of the recount.
16. Each election official is paid a \$50 stipend for assisting with a recount. The City Clerk's Office intended to use two teams (four election officials) for the recount in the Ward 4 Aldermanic race. The \$200 cost for conducting the recount is in addition to the \$40 recount fee required under RSA 669:31 II,c.
17. The recount of the votes cast in the Ward 4 Aldermanic race was cancelled by the Board of Aldermen. Minutes attached.
18. N/A. Fee was not paid and there was no written agreement in place to pay for the cost of the recount. The Board of Aldermen had authority for decisions relative to the recount, not the City Clerk.
19. See answer to #18. Further, RSA 669:31 II,d states that "the candidate...shall agree in writing with the town clerk to pay any additional cost of the recount" and no such agreement was in place.
20. Sec. 23 and 26 of the City Charter are specific as to the time that a recount is to take place: First, the return of votes for the November 6, 2007 election were to be canvassed "in the evening on the Tuesday next following such election," i.e. November 13, 2007. The Board of Aldermen shall then, "at said meeting, or at an adjourned meeting or meetings specifically held for that purpose within one week thereafter...recount the ballots..." As such, the earliest date that the recount could be scheduled was November 13th and the latest date that the recount could be scheduled was November 20th. Dates within that time period, which were not in conflict with already-scheduled Aldermanic committee meetings, were November 16, November 17, and November 18.



I the undersigned candidate for Ward 4 Alderman in the Nov 6, 2007 election held 2 days ago, Dr Andrew Tempelman, herewith request a hand-count of the ballots cast for the position of Ward Alderman for Ward 4 on that day.

I have requested that the count be held immediately since I suspect foul play and wanted no more time to elapse than necessary, but my request has been denied by deputy clerk Lucier who informed me that the recount will not be permitted by the senior clerk, who was not in his office today, 2 days after the election, until probably Nov 17, a Saturday. This puts 11 days between the time of the election and the time of the manual recount, enough time for further tampering with the ballots. Do not pretend that these things cannot happen in Nashua. They have happened all too frequently in too many places in the land of 'the free and the home of the brave.' The city clerk had a motive for destroying my chances of winning. This will be disclosed publicly in time, as will other grounds for suspicion of ballot tampering.

Please let me know in writing precisely when and where the manual recount will take place.

Let it be noted that I submitted a written request for an immediate hand recount of the ballots cast for Alderman of the 4th Ward on Nov 8, 2007, the 2nd day after the election. One reason for this request was that I had long-standing plans to be away from Nashua and out of the country for a couple of weeks. Thus I requested a recount as soon as possible. I could not be present for a Nov 17 recount, and thus I have not been able to respond in any fashion to City Clerk Bergeron's demands for money prior to recounting the ballots, until now that I have returned to the city and have been able to organize some sort of response. Let it also be noted for the Dec 6 deadline that I have incurred no further expenses for the election, nor received any further, or any, contributions from any donors. My response to the City Clerk on the recount matter is as follows:

These questions are asked by Dr Andrew Tempelman, candidate for Ward 4 Alderman, who requested a hand recount of the ballots for that position in the Nov 6, 2007 election. Please provide answers to the following questions under the constraints of New Hampshire state law, RSA 91, the Right to Know Law, within 5 working days as required by law. Send the answers to Dr Andrew Tempelman, 4 Kinsley Street, Nashua 03060.

1. What were the exact total numbers of votes cast on the voting ballot machine for Plamondon and for Tempelman on Nov 6, 2007?
2. Why were these numbers presented on TV Channel 13 507 for Plamondon and 207 for Tempelman, whereas the numbers you sent me were 502 for Plamondon and 210 for Tempelman?
3. What person announced the numbers of votes cast to the assembled candidate(s) after the polls closed Nov 6, 2007, as those numbers were determined by the adding mechanism inside the vote counting machine?
4. What persons (by name and with their telephone numbers) actually witnessed, saw with their own eyes, the numbers on the machine of votes cast for Plamondon and for Tempelman in the 4th Ward Alderman race after 8 pm on Nov 6, 2007? Please list the names of each person other than Ward 4 Polling Place Moderator David Davis who saw the numbers on the machine and can confirm that the numbers reported by him were actually the numbers on the machine?
5. Please list the names, addresses, and telephone numbers of each of Nashua's 9 ward election day moderators who were in charge of the polling places on Nov 6, 2007.

6. Who called in the numbers from each ward to Carolyn Choate at Channel 13 TV for the 1st broadcast of the returns—returns which she then posted and broadcasted?
7. How many blank ballots were issued to Moderator Davis in Ward 4 before the election?
8. How many blank ballots were left over, unused, after the election in Ward 4?
9. Who were the persons who were made aware of the total number of ballots cast and the total number of ballots left over unused after the election in Ward 4?
10. And if no persons were asked to witness these numbers in Ward 4, why were they not asked, since that would be a solid proof of a pure election, and the failure to ask such a small number of persons to verify these numbers would invite suspicion of the desire to keep the numbers unknown for ulterior reasons?
11. Alternatively, was any bar-code or other minute numbering system used to keep track of the total number of ballots printed, so that every ballot, used or unused, could be accounted for and verified by its place within batches of ballots issued to each polling place?
12. And if no such system of perfect check on the number of ballots used and unused was in place, why was it not? If these numbers are not known, or if the number of ballots actually used are not counted in order to keep an absolutely foolproof failsafe method in place, why are such numbers not kept? Why should suspicion not rest upon those controlling the counting of ballots for failing to use such a simple failsafe method of preventing tampering with the vote numbers by a post-election filling in of blank ballots.

(We remember Jos Stalin's observation that it's not the votes that count, but the counters of the votes that really count. This is the real-politik that we face in this matter today.)

13. Who called the numbers from each polling place in to Channel 13 that evening?
14. Were any of the numbers from any ward called in to the City Clerk's office before they were called into Channel 13 that evening?
15. You have quoted the state law RSA 660 stating the rules for recounting votes. There was no rule in that statute that the fees must be paid prior to the recount which you stated were required for a recount. Instead the New Hampshire law states that **if** the candidate has paid prior to the recount, the amount of the repayment shall be repaid after the recount depending upon the margin of the recount.

II. The applicant shall pay to the town clerk, for the use of the town, the following fee:

(a) If the difference between the vote cast for the applying candidate and a candidate declared elected is less than one percent of the total votes cast, the fee shall be \$10.

(b) If the difference between the vote cast for the applying candidate and a candidate declared elected is between one percent and 2 percent of the total votes cast, the fee shall be \$20.

(c) If the difference between the vote cast for the applying candidate and a candidate declared elected is between 2 percent and 3 percent of the total votes cast, the fee shall be \$40.

(d) If the difference between the vote cast for the applying candidate and a candidate declared elected is greater than 3 percent of the total votes cast, the candidate shall pay the fee as provided in RSA 669:31, II(c) and shall agree in writing with the town clerk to pay any additional costs of the recount.

III. If any person who has applied for a recount is declared elected by reason of the recount, the town clerk shall return to the person within 10 days of the recount all fees paid at the time of applying.

Notice that there is no statement that the fees shall be paid before the recount. Instead the payment is prescribed to be made after the margin of victory has been confirmed one way or the other. 'Repayment' or 'return of fees paid' is to be made only if the candidate has elected to pay in advance. But no such amount as \$240.00 which you dictate is stated at any point in the New Hampshire RSA.

16. Please quote any other statutory source which you may have followed for the \$240.00 prior payment fee which you demanded. Otherwise please admit that you have once again as the Nashua City Clerk interpreted the law according to your whim.
17. Did you in fact have the votes for Alderman of Ward 4 recounted as requested by me in writing with my signature on Nov 8?
18. Should you not have honored my request for a recount when you heard nothing by way of response from me, the candidate, since you also demanded my signature a second time, whereas you already had that the first time with my written request?
19. Why did you not exercise that option according to the state law so that at least the votes would have been recounted, and then charged me afterward according to the state law?
20. The city ordinance you cited states that the Aldermen must hold any recount of votes 'on the Tuesday next following such election' if possible, or within the following week if that be not possible. Please state why it was not possible for the

Aldermen to hold the recount as soon as possible after the election, rather than as long as possible after the election.

21. Did you request the Aldermen to supervise the recount as soon as possible as the law requires?
22. Or was it you who requested a delay of the recount?
23. If you delayed it, why did you delay it?
24. Please show evidence that you had Aldermanic approval for the late recount on Nov 17.
25. Which Aldermen were present when you made your request and who were they?
26. Did you, Paul Bergeron, Nashua City Clerk, send the police to harrass me, candidate Andrew Tempelman at any point during the heavy rains of election day Nov 6 at the Ledge Street polling place?
27. Did you send the police to any other place during that day?
28. Where did you send them?






