FUTSAL COURT

Cost: \$20,000

Location: Ash Street (next to the Skate Park)

Description: The game of futsal is similar to soccer. Both games are played with the feet - no hands. And both games are played in a rectangular playing area with the objective for each team to put the ball in the opponent's net. However, there are a lot of differences between the two games. Futsal can be played in an area not much bigger than a basketball court, there are fewer players per team and the nets are smaller. Funds for this project would go towards fencing, netting, pavement repair and court markings.



PORTABLE GAGA PIT

Cost: \$2,500

Location: Various

Description: Gaga is a fast paced, high energy sport played in an octagonal pit. The more players the better! Dubbed a kinder gentler version of dodge ball, the game is played with a soft foam ball, and combines the skills of dodging, striking, running, and jumping, while trying to hit opponents with a ball below the knees. The proposal here is to secure a portable Gaga Pit that can be brought to different areas of the city and keep secured at identified locations. Bring on the fun!



RAIL TRAIL IMPROVEMENTS

Cost: \$25,000

Location: Rail Trail

Description: The Nashua Heritage Rail Trail is an asset for the Tree Streets Neighborhood. This project will improve the Rail Trail by adding amenities such as trash receptacles, seating, and signage. Landscaping will improve safety on the trail by cleaning up overgrown areas and improving visibility, and it will also beautify the trail by removing stumps, fixing broken fencing and adding planters.



COMMUNITY GARDENS

Cost: \$15,000

Location: Rail Trail, between Vine Street and Ash Street

Description: Grow Nashua would create and support foraging spaces where berry bushes can be grown to supply fresh fruit for the neighborhood to enjoy. The recently rehabilitated "Mother's Garden" between Ash Street and Vine Street would be expanded to allow more families to be served. Overgrown areas will be cleaned up and made more suitable for parents and children and a play structure will be added so the little ones will be happily entertained while their moms are gardening!



PORTABLE SPEED FEEDBACK SIGNS

Cost: \$12,000

Location: Various

Description: Concerned about the speed of vehicles in your neighborhood? Vote for Driver Speed Feedback display signs. We can purchase two (2) portable signs to be placed around the neighborhood to help let drivers know to slow down when they exceed the speed of the roadway. These signs are lightweight and can be easily installed in appropriate locations.



TRASH RECEPTACLES AND DOG WASTE STATIONS

Cost: \$10,000

Location: TBD, based on neighborhood input

Description: We want to help keep the neighborhood clean and discourage littering by making sure there are plenty of trash cans and dog waste bags available throughout the area. We'll have a map set up at the "Your Voice, Your Choice!" Project Expo so you can help us identify the best locations to place receptacles.



STREET ART

Cost: \$10,000

Location: 41 West Hollis Street & Los Amigos Park

Description: Positive Street Art will hold neighborhood workshops and put together a street art project that connects the Tree Streets with the people, giving power and a voice to both. Murals have social, cultural and economic benefits, as well as having a positive effect on mental health. They promote a sense of identity, belonging, attachment, welcoming and openness, and can enhance public safety by creating a feeling that a location is cared for, which makes crimes of opportunity less likely.



BUS SHELTER BY PALM SQUARE

Cost: \$22,000

Location: West Hollis Street, in front of Palm Square
Description: A bus shelter located by Palm Square, at the intersection of Palm Street and West Hollis Street, would provide a safe place for residents to wait for the bus out of the elements. Additionally it would provide a public space where art could be displayed for the enjoyment of the community.

LOS AMIGOS PARK IMPROVEMENTS

Cost: \$25,000

Location: Los Amigos Park (Ash Street)

Description: Updates to Los Amigos Park will provide new areas for active play for neighborhood children. Plans include five new play structures, including a slide, and a picnic table.
