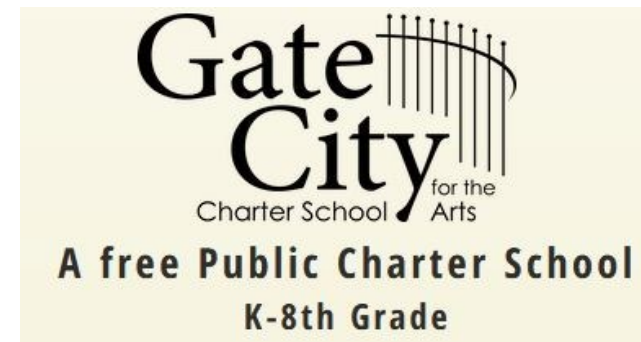

## ART CAMP DESCRIPTIONS

### Observational Drawing Workshop

Students will participate in a three day observational drawing workshop that begins with an exploration of nature at Benson's Park in Hudson, NH. Followed by careful study of composition and value at the Gate City Charter School for the Arts in Merrimack, NH. Using pencil and color pencil, students will learn to create highlights, shadows and texture.
