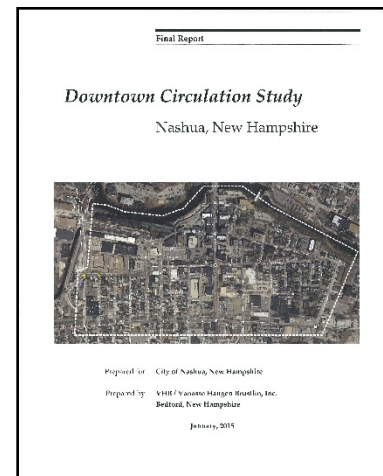
We may not be able to fund them through YVYC but we'll keep a record of them for future funding opportunities.

IDEAS THAT EXCEED THE \$25,000 BUDGET

- **Repave roads/Fix potholes**
 - ✓ Kinsley Street will be paved this year
- **Repair sidewalks**
- **More street lighting**
 - ✓ Please send locations where you think lighting is needed to Julie Chizmas at chizmasj@nashuanh.gov
- **New parks/Playgrounds/Baseball park**
- **Dog park**
- **Community Center**
- **Public pool**
- **Public bathrooms at parks**
- **Splash pads**
 - ✓ Full bathroom facilities are required within 200 feet of a splash pad, which makes this idea exceed the \$25,000 budget
- **Parking lot with free or low cost parking**
- **New traffic signal at Vine Street and West Hollis Street**
- **Reconfigure traffic flow off of Broad Street Parkway**
 - ✓ The City is actively seeking funding to implement the findings of the [Downtown Circulation Study](#), which addresses traffic flow to and from the Broad Street Parkway
- **Rehab Elm Street School**
- **Indoor winter garden/Greenhouse**
- **Install seatbelts on school buses**

OTHER IDEAS THAT WE WILL TRY TO FUND OUTSIDE OF THIS PROGRAM

- **Install Wrong-Way street signs**
 - ✓ *The City is reviewing locations where there have been wrong-way crashes to determine where signs would be appropriate*
- **Install bike racks**
 - ✓ *Please send locations where you think bike racks should be installed to Julie Chizmas at chizmasj@nashuanh.gov*
- **Clean and aerate Sandy Pond**
 - ✓ *In 2018, the City used grant funding to remove invasive plant species from Sandy Pond and that program will continue in 2019*
- **Snow plowing on the Rail Trail**
 - ✓ *The City is actively working to improve plowing on the Rail Trail*

OTHER IDEAS (PLEASE SEE COMMENTS)

- **Various improvements on private property**
 - ✓ *Eligible projects are those that serve the general public*
- **Speed bumps to slow traffic**
 - ✓ *Speed bumps are typically found on private roadways and parking lots and are not recommended for public roadways*
- **Direct donation to families in need**
 - ✓ *The project aims to make improvements that can be enjoyed by many in the neighborhood*
- **Rehabilitate Hockey Court on Grand Avenue**
 - ✓ *Grand Avenue is outside of the project area*
- **Street Trees**
 - ✓ *The City has a Shade Tree program that provides reduced-cost or, for qualifying applicants, free trees for homeowners. For more information: <https://www.nashuanh.gov/DocumentCenter/View/5803/Shade-Tree-Program-PDF>*
- **Lending Book Tree**
 - ✓ *In addition to the Nashua Public Library, there are currently two Little Free Libraries in the Tree Streets Neighborhood: one on the Rail Trail near Pine Street and one at Park Social at Labine.*
- **Memorial Plaque**
 - ✓ *The specific plaque requested is not compliant with City policies.*
- **Community Christmas Tree**
 - ✓ *Since the City already has an official Christmas Tree, perhaps neighborhood businesses or organizations could fund one specifically for the neighborhood?*
